## **C.B.S.E SOUTH ZONE SKATING CHAMPIONSHIP 2017**

(September 18<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> 2017)

### **GUIDELINES FROM HOST SCHOOL**

1. We would like to inform all the participating school teams to send the consent form with complete address, telephone numbers, email address etc.
2. No school will be permitted to participate unless they fill the online Entry Performa.
3. Whatsoever the reason may be, on the spot entry, late entry and in person submission of entry Performa are strictly prohibited.
4. Teams without proper documents will not be allowed to participate in the championship.
5. All the teams shall be accompanied by a Coach and Manager designated by the participating school Principal.
6. A mandatory meeting with all the participating team coaches and Managers will be held on September 17, 2017 at 5.30 pm in the school premises for preliminary instructions.
7. Each school must issue an identity card to every player representing the school.
8. Outstation Teams have to report one day before the event. Boarding and lodging will be available from one day prior to the event and checkout time will be on or before 6:00 PM of September 21, 2017.
9. The teams are requested to inform the exact time of arrival to enable us to receive the teams at Tirupati Bus stand and railway station, failure of which may lead the team to make their own arrangements.
10. Every team should carry their school flag to be used for the March past and the various ceremonies. Participation in March past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.
11. It is the responsibility of the school/teams staying outside, to collect information in regard to program etc.
12. **Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the accommodation.**
13. All the schools who availed accommodation facility will have to deposit Rs.1, 000/- as caution deposit which is refundable. This caution deposit will not be refunded in case of any damage or loss to the property caused by a particular school team.
14. Dining in the cafeteria is mandatory for all the teams availing accommodation arranged by the host school.
15. It is compulsory for all the participants to attend the inauguration and valedictory functions.
16. Participants are not allowed to wear any costly ornaments or bring any valuable items. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any articles during their stay.
17. Consumption of liquor, drugs, tobacco in any form is strictly prohibited during the conduct of the championship and stay in the Stadium or school. Anyone who violates this rule will be immediately asked to leave the campus and the team will be disqualified.

18. Any damage done to the property of the school/ accommodation during the stay by the participant will have to be compensated for, by the respective school.
19. The organizers reserve the right to debar a player / coach / manager from the competition arena for unruly behavior / interference in the smooth conduct of events of the competition.
20. It is the responsibility of the team manager to bring the sick/injured player to the First-Aid committee.
21. The school should follow the age norms strictly.

### **DISQUALIFICATION**

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.

1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
2. Misbehavior / Use of abusive language on ground by player or accompanying official
3. Damaging the school property
4. The Organizing School in no case shall show the eligibility Performa or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only jury of appeal's prerogative to verify all the documents.

### **PROTEST**

Protest of any nature in connection with the championship shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within 15 minutes of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand).

Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of following: -

1. Principal, Organizing School
2. Organizing Secretary
3. CBSE Observer
4. One or two technically qualified people present at the venue

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is upheld, the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

### **▪ The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.**

The decision, together with full facts of the protest may immediately be reported to the Joint (Sports) CBSE Director.

### **MEDALS AND CERTIFICATES**

No Participation Certificate shall be given to a player/team that does not play after reporting.

Decision of the game officials is final.
