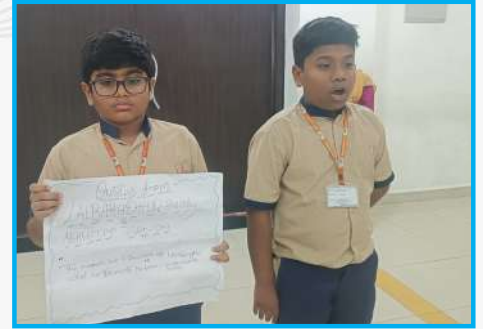
Media Club explored “Coin Minting Places in India”! From punch-marked coins to modern minting , students dived into currency evolution, culture & civic learning.

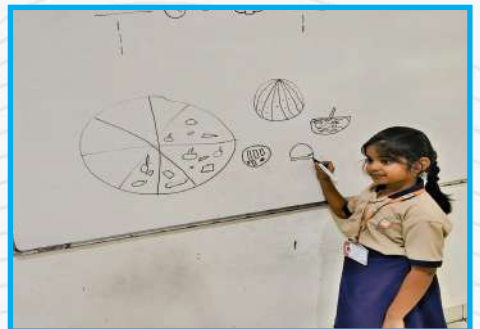
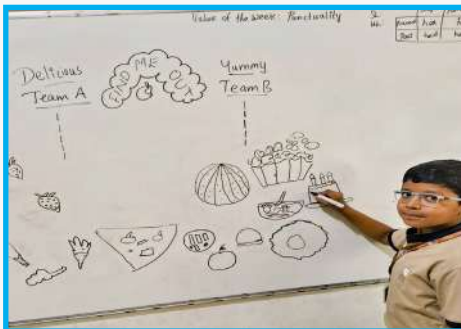
## Paneer Toast Sandwich & Cucumber Boats

## Tangy Guava Bowl & Chocolate Biscuit Pops

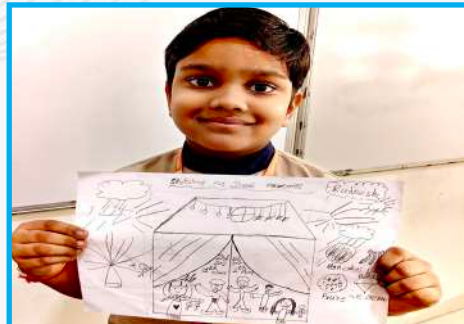

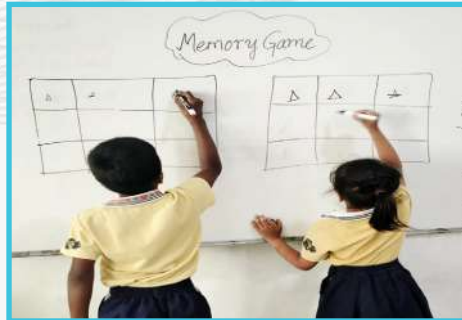
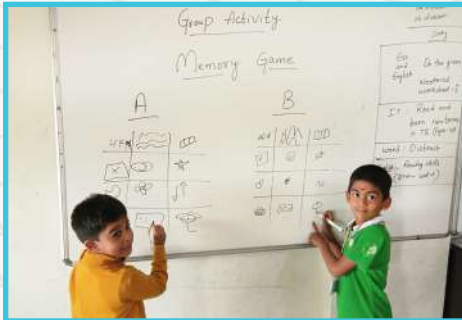




## GRADE - II

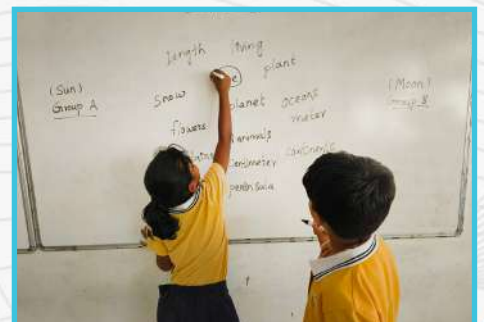
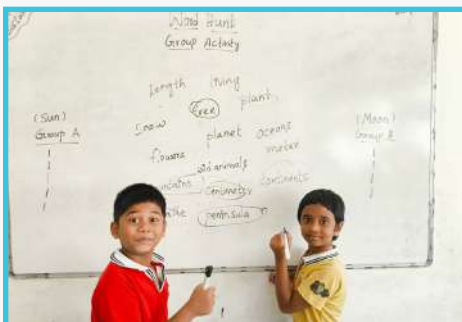
### Hopscotch on Helping Verbs

### Cinema and Sense

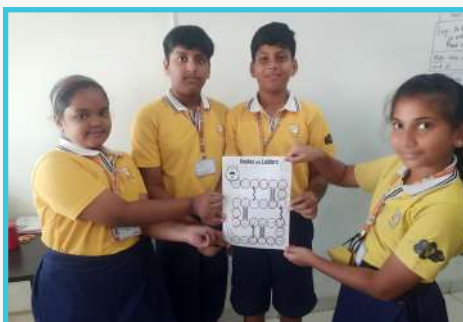

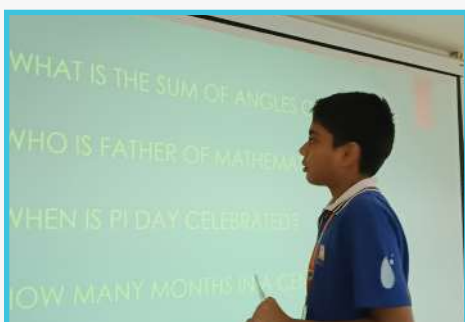
### Language Quiz

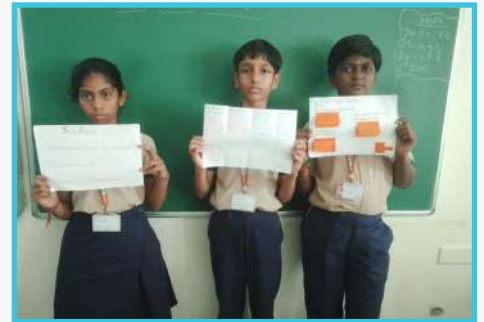




## CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES
